




Overview: Bello the Cello is a fun children's book that introduces different types of instruments and how Bello the Cello discovers his gift, the magic of his song.





Bello the Cello Vocabulary Words-Answer Key

Tail Piece

this anchors one end of the strings.

Fine Tyners

small metal screws attached to the top of the tailpiece to help tune the instrument

F- Holes

the sound holes

Bridge

that transmits the Vibrations of the string to the resonating body.

Vocabulary Words-Answer Key

Scroll

the head of the violin

Pegs

a wooden piece in a musical instrument that is turned to tighten or loosen a string.

Neck

the neck connects the fingerboard to the top of the instrument

the part of a
stringed
instrument against
which the fingers
press the strings_
